Ubi caritas et amor, Ubi caritas Deus ibi est.

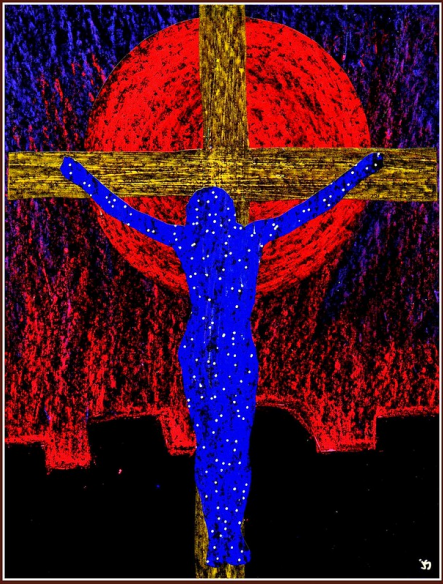
